CIP Community Improvement Plan

The City of Port Colborne offers a range of incentive programs for new or expanding businesses through the Community Improvement Plan Program (CIP).

For example, if you are a business or property owner, the Façade Improvement Program is structured as a matching grant where the City will provide a grant equal to 50% of the cost of eligible façade and storefront improvement and restoration works, up to a maximum grant per property/project of \$10,000.00.
