5. Niagara Region Accessibility Plan Presentations

- Town of Lincoln – Julie Kirkelos, Clerk

Julie outlined several initiatives being undertaken in Lincoln including exploring the use of AI technology and a Return-to-Work policy and process. Donna will circulate Julie's report with the minutes.

- Town of Pelham – William Tigert, Clerk

Bill reviewed a few projects being conducted by Pelham including Centennial Park washroom renovation, the Parking By-law Update and the potential adoption of Facility Design Guidelines for the Town which will include accessibility considerations.

- Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake – Lauren has committed to sending the municipality's report next week.
- Town of Grimsby – Mike Graybiel – Facilities and Parks

Mike informed the group that the Town is considering decommissioning some facilities due to age and the cost of retrofitting. Staff are currently finishing the Casablanca Waterfront Park which includes a ramp to the beach, a beach mat, and an accessible playground. JAAC will be invited to the grand opening. The Town continues to work on the Peach King Arena addition and is re-designing its accessible parking spaces to comply with the Design of Public Spaces Standard.
