By-Law No. 7449/33/26

Being a By-law to Amend By-law 6579/34/18, Being a By-law to Adopt a Municipal Alcohol Management Policy and to repeal various By-laws

Whereas on May 14, 2018, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne enacted By-law 6579/34/18, Being a By-law to Adopt a Municipal Alcohol Management Policy and to repeal various By-laws;

Whereas at its meeting of April 14, 2026, Council considered and approved the recommendation of Legislative Services, Report No. 2026-50, Subject: Amendments to Municipal Alcohol Management Policy;

Whereas Council is desirous of amending the Municipal Alcohol Management Policy in accordance with the recommendations in the above referenced report;

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne enacts as follows:

1. That By-law 6579/34/18, Being a By-law to Adopt a Municipal Alcohol Management Policy and to repeal various By-laws, be amended by adding the following thereto:


“Cultural or Community Event” means an organized outdoor gathering hosted by an individual and/or an individual on behalf of an organization for the purpose of arts, athletic, cultural, charitable, entertainment, and/or religious activities that is open to the general public and is not primarily intended for attendees under 19 years of age.”

2. That Section 3 of Schedule “A” to By-law 6579/34/18, Being a By-law to Adopt a Municipal Alcohol Management Policy and to repeal various By-laws, be amended by adding Section 3.4 with the following thereto:

Gaming eM
“In the event that this policy differs from the guidance provided from the Alcohol and ~~(Gambling)~~ Commission of Ontario, including but not limited to the Registrar’s Interim Standards and Requirements for Liquor and Ontario statutes and regulations, the guidance provided by the Alcohol and ~~(Gambling)~~ Commission of Ontario takes precedence over any section of this policy.” *Gaming eM*

3. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day of passing.
