# TOP 10 VIOLATIONS OF THE BY-LAW:



#### Fire Size

Fire is to be no larger than 1m (3') in diameter and 0.6m (2') in height.



# **Vertical Clearance**

5m (16.5') top of fire pit to combustibles.



## **Permitted Hours**

Burning is permitted until 11 p.m.



# **Burning Materials**

Only burn clean, dry firewood.



# **Nuisance**

Make sure smoke is not bothering your neighbours.



# Wind Speed

Be mindful of direction/intensity.



## **Combustibles**

Fire must be at least 3m (10') away from combustibles.



# Containment

Fire must be contained at all times.



# **Attended**

Fire must be supervised by someone 18+.



# **Extinguishing**

Only use water to extinguish, not extinguishing agents.
