This Request for Quotations (the "RFQ") is an invitation by the Corporation of the City of Port Colborne (the "City") to prospective proponents to submit quotations for the supply and delivery of Washroom/Changeroom & Staff/First Aid Trailer for Nickel Beach.

Recently the building that formerly housed washroom facilities at Nickel Beach has been decommissioned as they were beyond repair and were inaccessible for servicing by sewage pump trucks and water delivery. With the increasing demand for visiting Nickel Beach in the last few summers and the Splashtown Niagara floating waterpark that is scheduled for the summer of 2022 the City of Port Colborne is investing in modern facilities to enhance the beach visitors experience.

The City is inviting proposals from qualified suppliers to design and build two (2) Portable Washroom/Changeroom Trailers c/w Waste & Water Units and a Portable Staff & First Aid Refuge Trailer for deployment at Nickel Beach in Port Colborne.
