

The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne

By-law No. 7485/69/26

Being a By-Law to Amend Amend By-Law No. 6082/48/14, as amended, being a By-Law to establish a system for administrative penalties respecting the stopping, standing and parking of vehicles within the City of Port Colborne

Whereas Section 5(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, provides that the powers of a municipality shall be exercised by its council; and

Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne (Council) enacted By-law No. 6082/48/14, Being a By-Law to establish a system for administrative penalties respecting the stopping, standing and parking of vehicles within the City of Port Colborne, on the 12th day of May 2014;

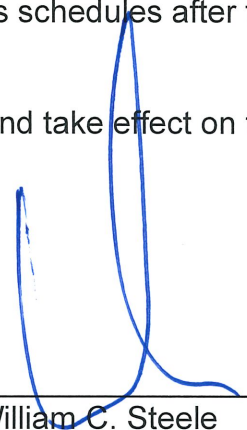
Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne enacts as follows:

1. That By-Law 6082/48/14, as amended, be further amended to include the following under Schedule "C":

ITEM	COLUMN 1 Designated Provisions	COLUMN 2 Short Form Wording	COLUMN 3 Administrative Penalty
8. a.	3.4 (c)(i)	Stop/Stand/Park Without a Permit (NB Zone 1)	\$120
8. b.	3.4(c)(ii)	Stop/Stand/Park Without a Permit (NB Zone 2)	\$80

2. The Clerk is authorized to affect any minor modifications, corrections, or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical, or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this bylaw.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the passing.
