

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PORT COLBORNE

BY-LAW NO. 5689/120/11

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 5328/83/09 BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH A COMMITTEE KNOWN AS THE "PORT COLBORNE SENIORS ADVISORY COUNCIL" AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS THERETO**

**WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne enacted By-law 5328/83/09, Being a By-law to Establish a Committee known as the "Port Colborne Seniors Advisory Council" and to Provide for the Appointment of Members Thereto, on June 8, 2009;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne approved the recommendations of Department of Community & Corporate Services, Community Services Division, Report No. 2011-24, Subject: Senior Advisory Council Terms of Reference Amendment on September 12, 2011;

**AND WHEREAS** Council is desirous of amending the number of voting members for the Senior Advisory Council.

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PORT COLBORNE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the Terms of Reference for the Port Colborne Seniors Advisory Council, as contained in By-law 5328/83/09, Being a By-law to Establish a Committee Known as the "Port Colborne Seniors Advisory Council" and to Provide for the Appointment of Members Thereto, be amended by deleting the following from Section 2:


"(a) Five members, fifty-five years or older and residing in Port Colborne, as appointed by City Council;"

and substituting the following:

"(a) Up to ten voting members, fifty-five years or older and residing in the City of Port Colborne, who shall be appointed by resolution of City Council;"

2. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day of its final passing.
