## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PORT COLBORNE

BY-LAW NO. 5689/120/11

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 5328/83/09 BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH A COMMITTEE KNOWN AS THE "PORT COLBORNE SENIORS ADVISORY COUNCIL" AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS THERETO

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne enacted By-law 5328/83/09, Being a By-law to Establish a Committee known as the "Port Colborne Seniors Advisory Council" and to Provide for the Appointment of Members Thereto, on June 8, 2009;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne approved the recommendations of Department of Community & Corporate Services, Community Services Division, Report No. 2011-24, Subject: Senior Advisory Council Terms of Reference Amendment on September 12, 2011;

**AND WHEREAS** Council is desirous of amending the number of voting members for the Senior Advisory Council.

## NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PORT COLBORNE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Terms of Reference for the Port Colborne Seniors Advisory Council, as contained in By-law 5328/83/09, Being a By-law to Establish a Committee Known as the "Port Colborne Seniors Advisory Council" and to Provide for the Appointment of Members Thereto, be amended by deleting the following from Section 2:
  - "(a) Five members, fifty-five years or older and residing in Port Colborne, as appointed by City Council;"

and substituting the following:

- "(a) Up to ten voting members, fifty-five years or older and residing in the City of Port Colborne, who shall be appointed by resolution of City Council;"
- 2. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day of its final passing.
