Looking to park within walking distance? We have options:

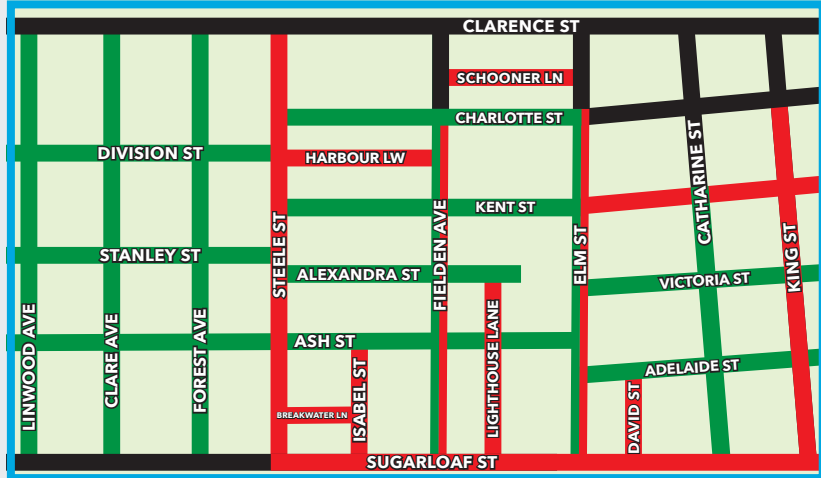
1. Park for FREE before 3pm in designated parking areas (see the map) with registration on the Honk Mobile App.
2. Park after 3pm in designated parking areas and pay \$20 using the Honk Mobile App.
3. Park 10am to 11pm Friday to Sunday or 10am to 5pm on Monday at 11 King Street parking lot or after 4pm Friday to Sunday at the H.H. Knoll Lakeview Park boat launch ramp parking lot and pay \$30 using the Honk Mobile App.
4. Display your PORTicipate Pass in the windshield of your car for FREE parking in any designated parking areas anytime during the festival.

CANAL DAYS CONCERT SERIES POLICIES

1. The Concert Series is a free, all-ages event.
2. Wrist bands are required to purchase alcohol tickets.
3. Must be 19 years of age to obtain a wrist band. Security will ID at the gate.
4. Tickets are obtained from the ticket tent to be used to obtain beer/coolers at the beer tent.
5. Donations are encouraged at the entrances to help keep concerts free and support local community groups/charities.
6. No pets are permitted in the concert venue. Service dogs are permitted.
7. The concert venue is a smoke/vape/cannabis free event in accordance with Regional No Smoking By-law 112-2013.
8. No outside beverages are allowed in the concert venue unless nonalcoholic beverages are in a sealed bottle (i.e. water/pop).
9. Outside food is permitted in the concert venue.
10. Outside chairs are permitted in designated area.
11. All bags are subject to a bag check by security.
12. Drink tickets are valid all weekend.
